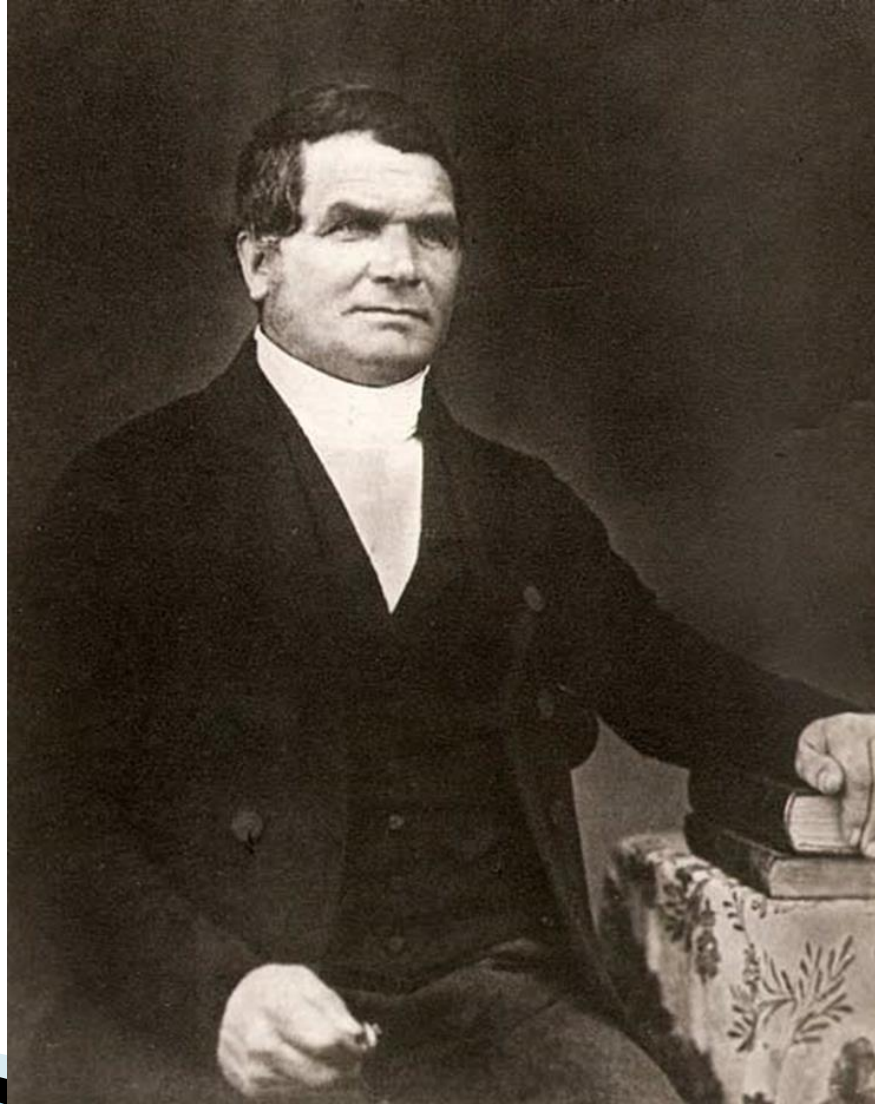

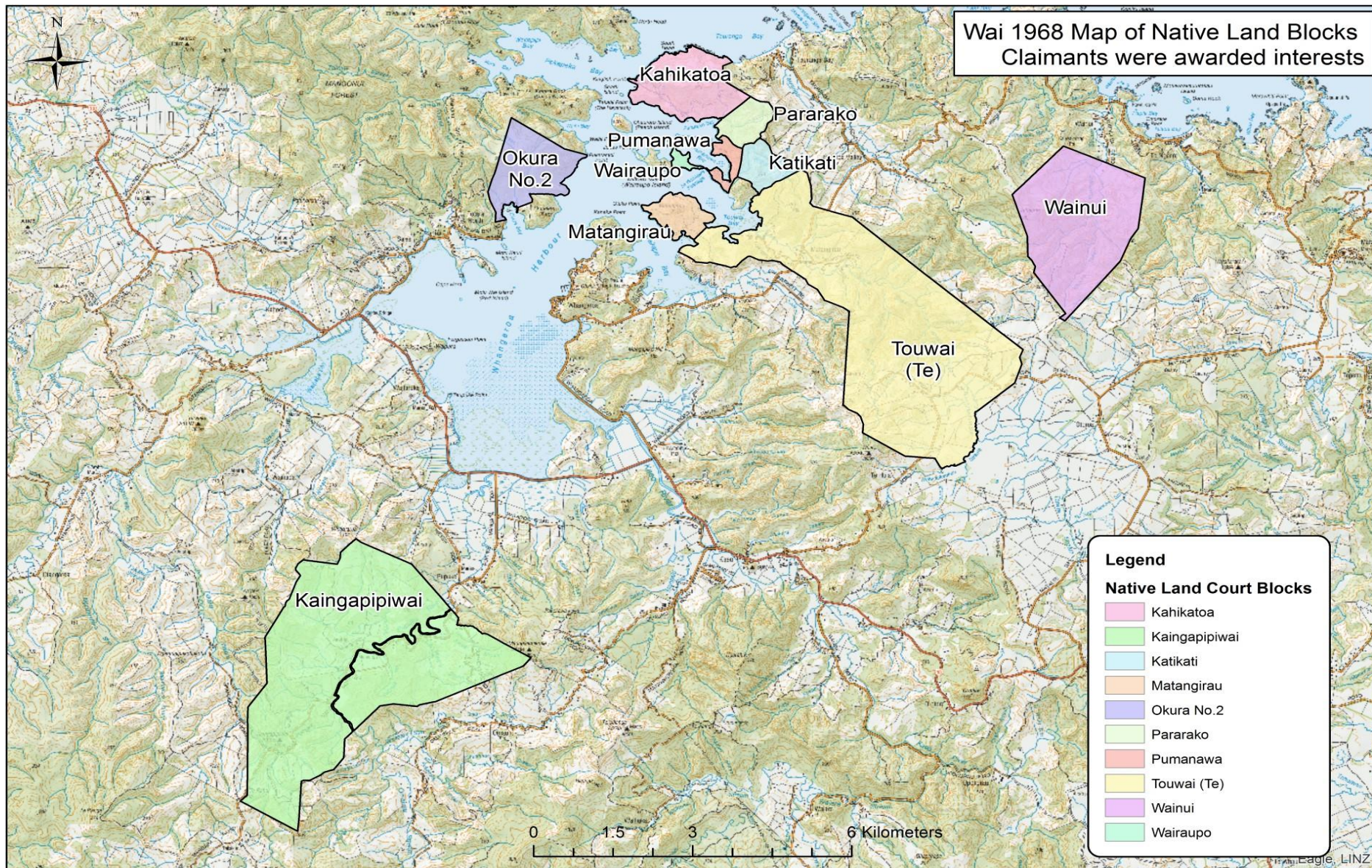

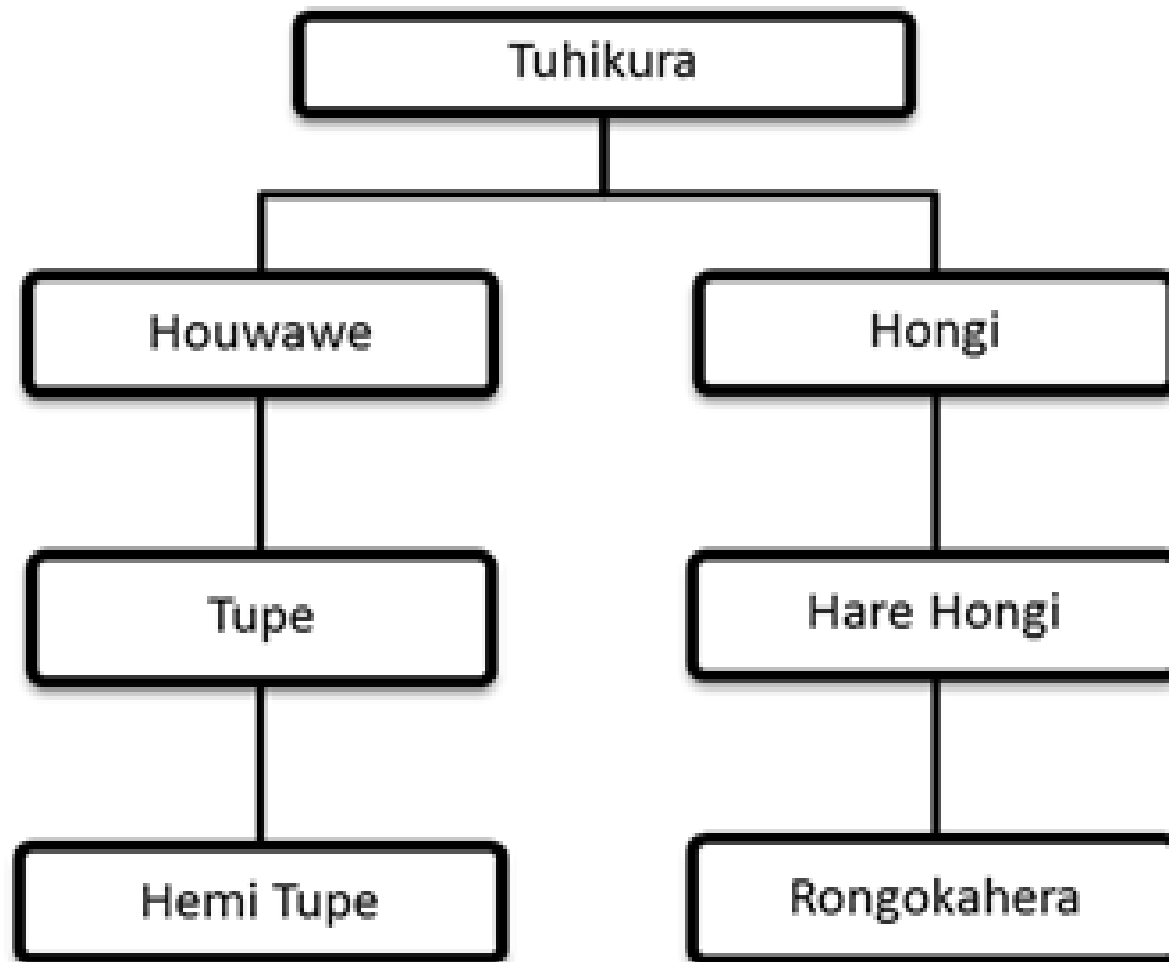
The rohe of Te Puta included Matangirau



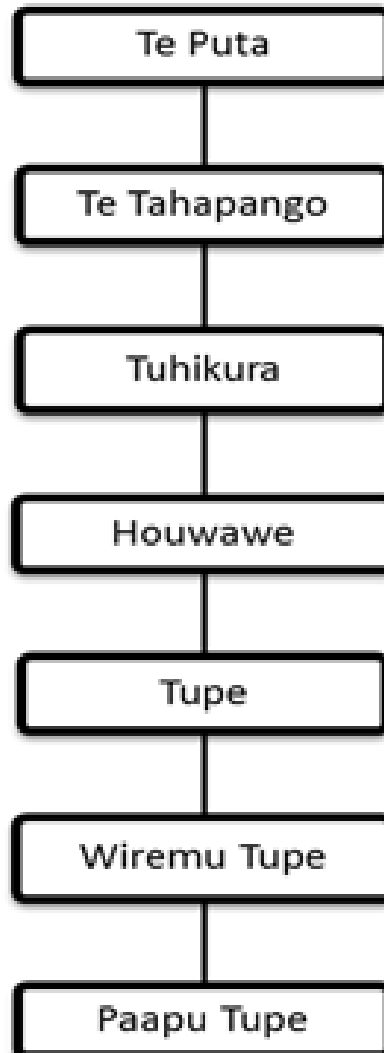
Native Land blocks awarded to my tūpuna



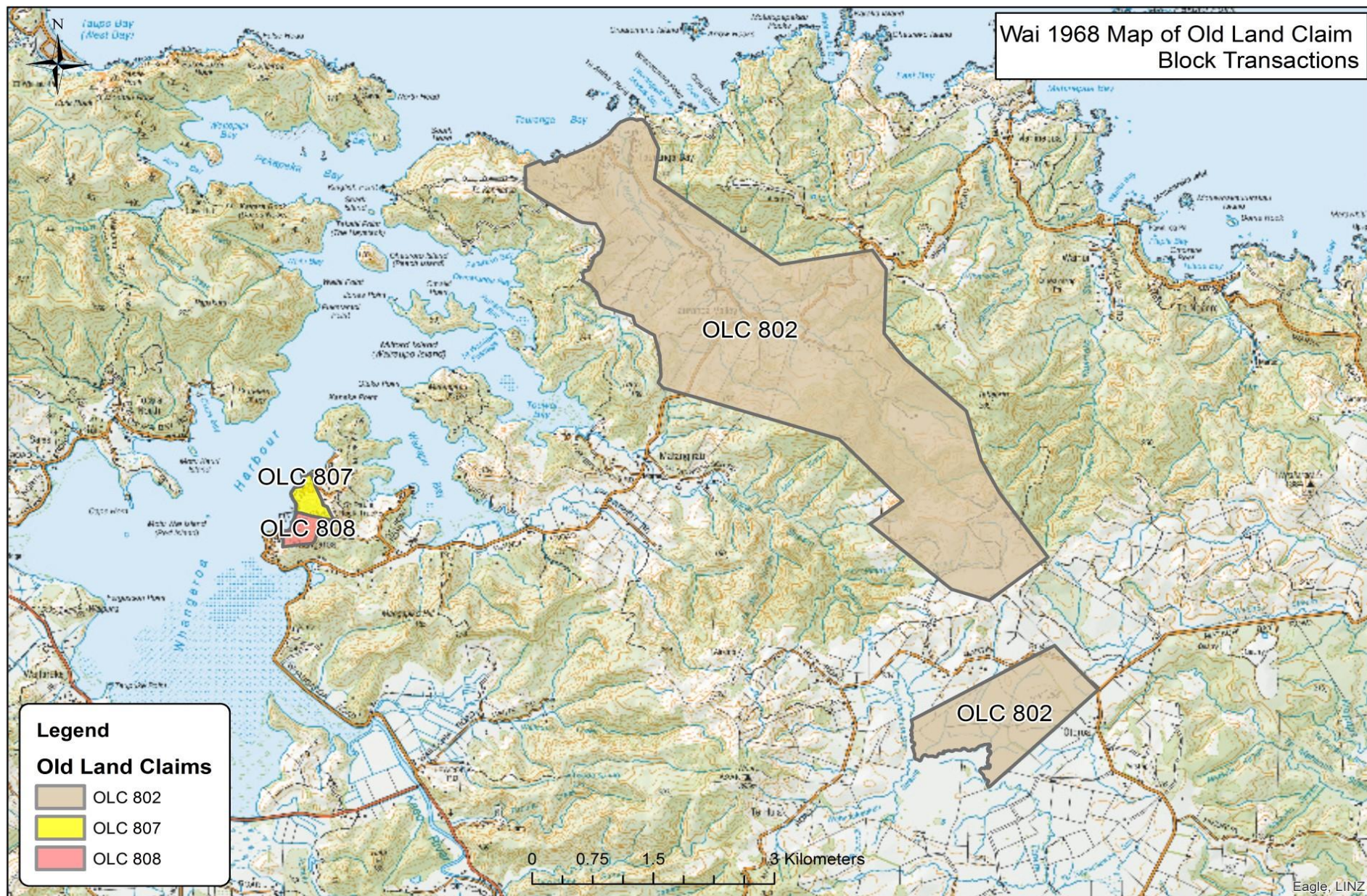

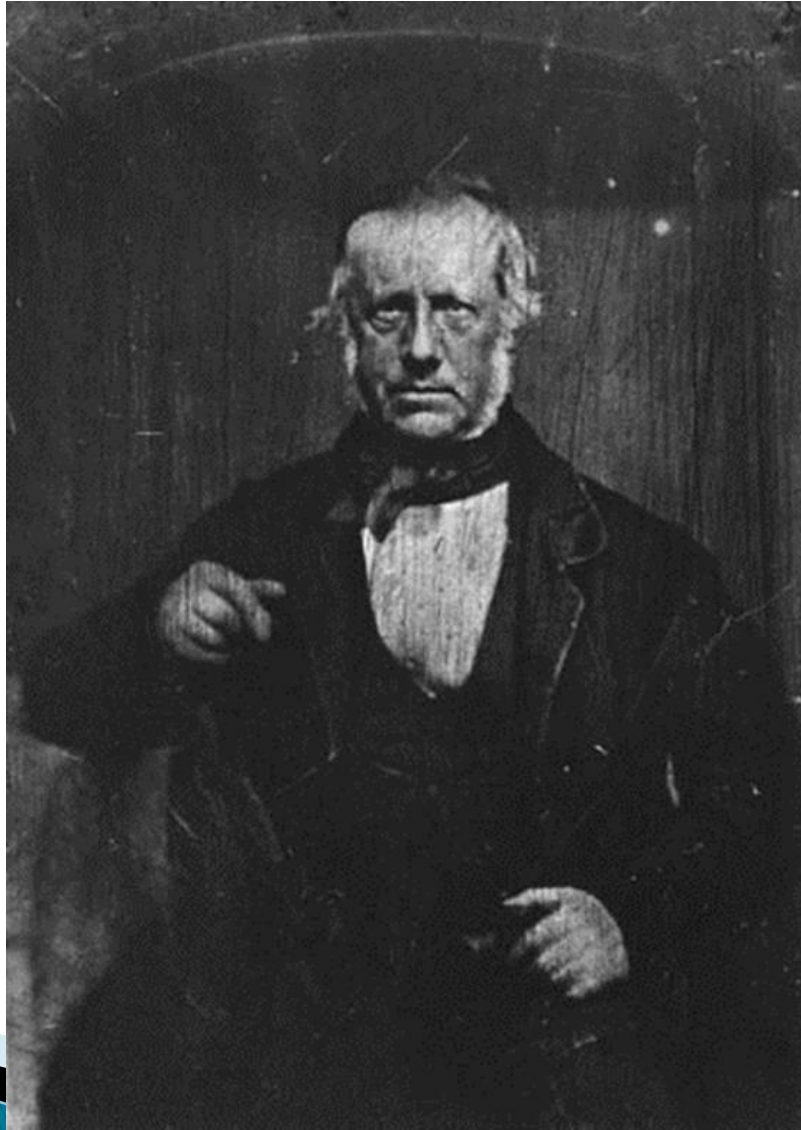

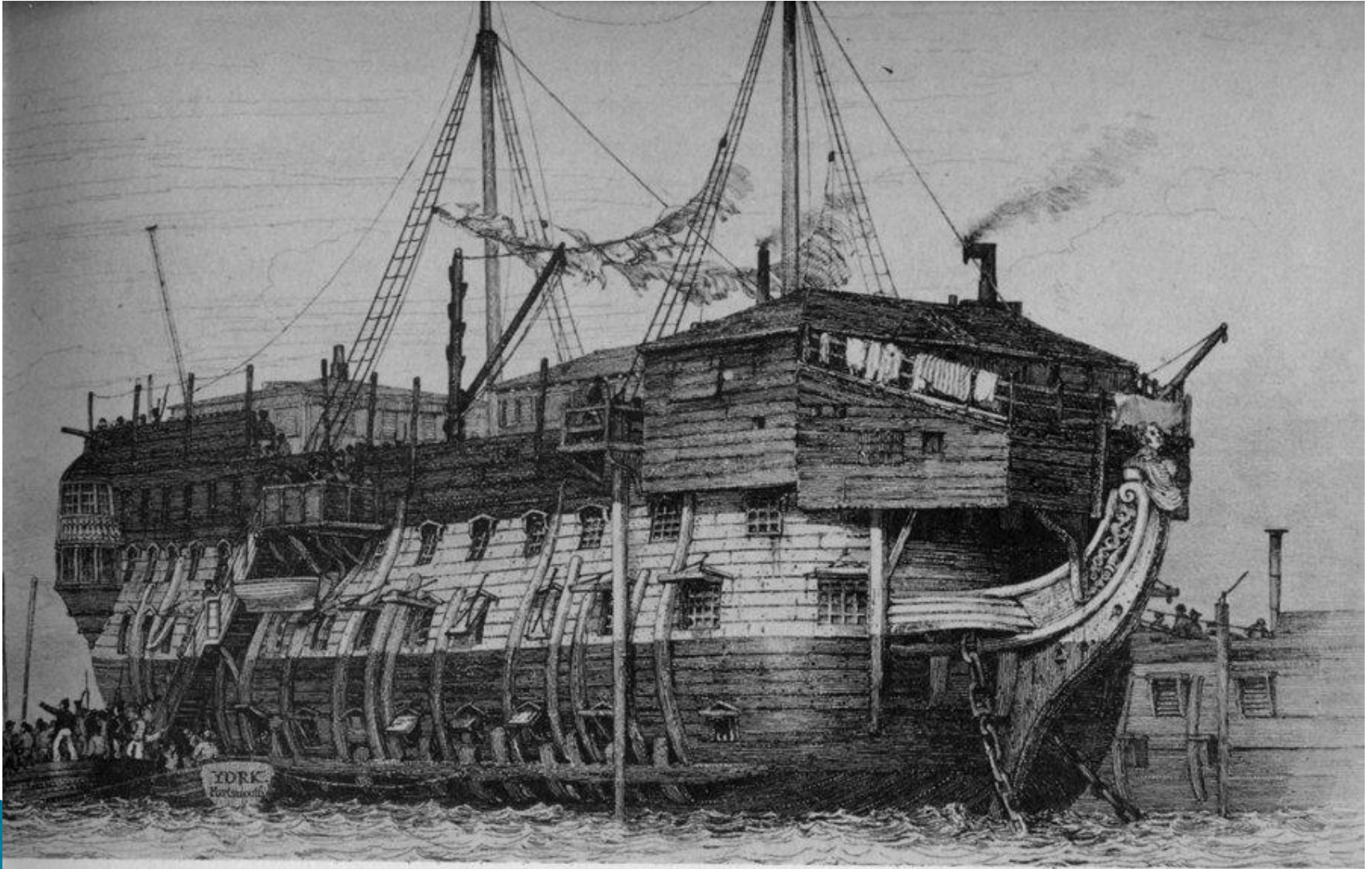

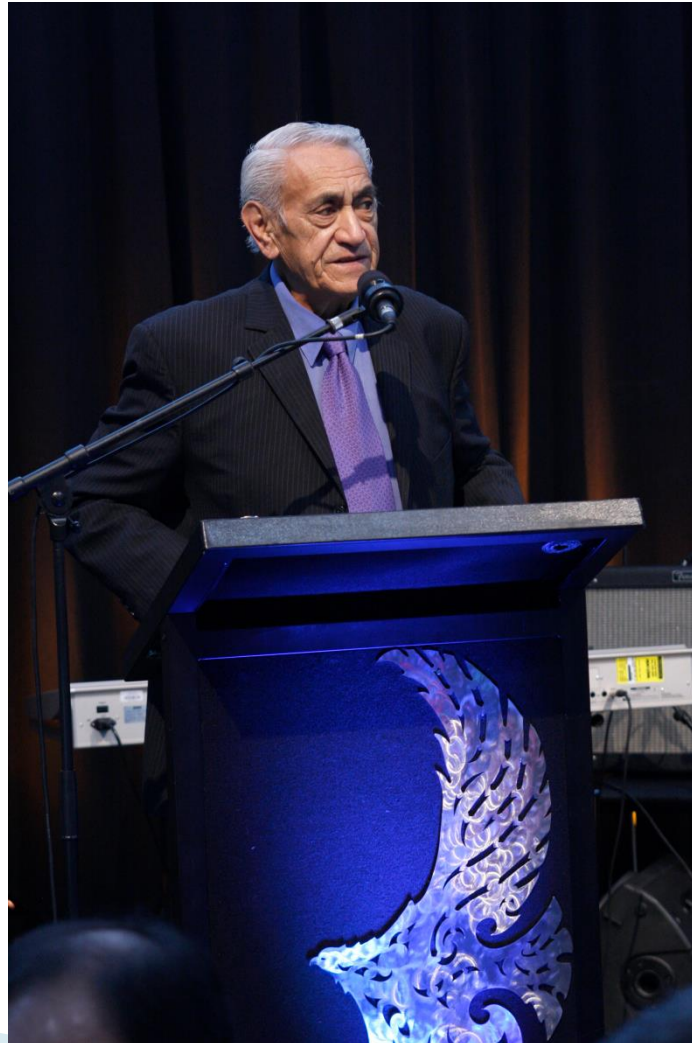

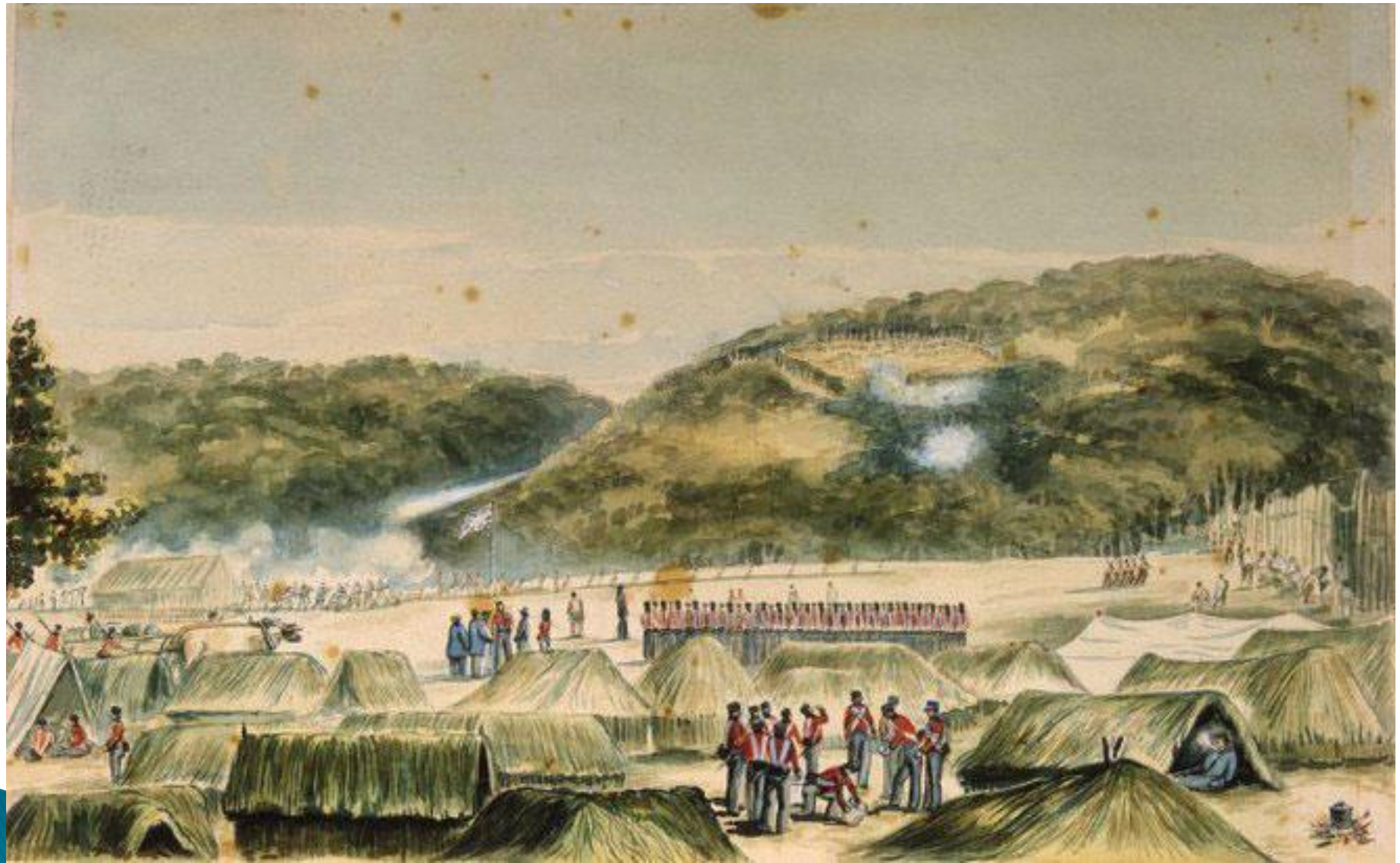
